In 1992, AutoCAD was available for IBM RS/6000-based computers, and in 1993, for the HP-UX operating system. In 1994, AutoCAD for Windows 95 and Windows NT was released. Early versions of AutoCAD ran under DOS in 16-bit real mode and lacked many of the advanced features that later versions have. AutoCAD for DOS had a maximum screen resolution of only 640×480 pixels. An Apple II version of AutoCAD only had a resolution of 400×300 pixels. The initial version of AutoCAD for DOS supported only a small number of peripherals. For example, the first version of AutoCAD for DOS only supported a dot-matrix printer or keyboard. Later versions of AutoCAD introduced a parallel port interface for the first time, which enables USB or serial port connections.

Hampshire to target Reds Jake White has chosen the onus to fight England selection by guiding his county side to a seven-wicket win over Nottinghamshire. The 26-year-old Warwickshire all-rounder fell to the second ball of the innings, but White's men, in their first three-day match of the season, saw off their visitors by 179 runs with two sessions to spare. Nathan Astle (3-16) took four of the five wickets to fall, while Martin McCalmán (2-25) and Gary Wilson (2-26) also claimed two each. With Durham their hosts for the first time in the LV= County Championship, Hampshire struggled in their second game of the season, having collected just 11 points from their opening six games. Hampshire's ODI record is better, with four wins and two losses from five matches. But the hosts have a way to go if they are to reach the threshold of their target of eight points from the 21 points available, considering they have played more games than their opponents. "It's been a great start for us," said White. "We've always been a great ODI side, but we need to get back into the Championship and that is going to be challenging. "But we've been seeing pretty good bowling these last few weeks and it's been going well. Our fielding has been as good as we have ever had and we've scored plenty of runs, but we have let ourselves down a bit with the bat. "This was another one where we have looked after the new ball, bowled the right lengths and our batsmen have got themselves out of trouble." Despite their opening position, Hampshire batted impressively and chased down Nottinghamshire's 222 for seven in 34.4 overs with 16 balls to spare. Needing 201, they needed to score in four and a half sessions and White's openers were soon in trouble. Tim Murtagh (3) and Callum Thorp (19) were both run out off the second and third balls, and the second wicket pair were 17 for the fourth over. Hampshire's openers Nick Knight (16) and Dan Redfern (33) added just 12 before the latter was dismissed by Astle for his third wicket. James Tredwell, who was the last England wicket to fall in the

I'm most excited about the Live Markup Assist. I've been fiddling with it a bit to get it working for importing PDF's, but it's been very challenging to get it working on my machine.
