you may donate blood when you are healthy and your blood cells (hematocrit) are high. usually, the red blood cells (rbcs) are around 45%. this is enough blood to make a pint of whole blood. blood type in common with yours is the best blood to use. because of the way blood is donated, it is best to give blood that is about one day old or stored at room temperature. blood for plasma or serum can be donated any time, but it is usually done in the morning when blood cells are at their best. you must be fit and well rested, usually no less than eight hours after eating, drinking, or smoking. this will keep your blood cells active. people who donate blood are usually advised to keep the donated blood for about 24 hours, after which time it can be transfused into a patient. to check the blood, doctors put a special screening test into the blood and use a machine that will test for a variety of diseases, like the wbc (white blood cells). if the machine is not working, there are tests that can be done for the particular disease that the blood might have. hiv is a disease that kills or can kill the patient, so it is important to know if it is in your blood. hepatitis c, a blood-borne virus, can lead to scarring of the liver (cirrhosis) and damage to the liver cells called hepatocytes. people with hepatitis c are often diagnosed in their 40s or 50s. hepatitis c is spread mainly by direct contact with the blood of someone who has the virus, by contact with the infected blood of an open wound, or by contact with blood that has been contaminated with infected blood. health care workers and people in the medical and dental professions are at increased risk for becoming infected with hepatitis c because they may be exposed to infected blood by injury or a cut that has not been properly disinfected or rendered free of blood. sexual partners of infected health care workers are also at increased risk of getting hepatitis c. the hepatitis c virus typically remains dormant in the body for decades, but the activity of the virus can be increased by hepatitis b or other liver disease. someone who has been infected with hepatitis c can clear the virus from his or her blood within 2-10 years, but many people who have hepatitis c have some degree of liver damage, even if their levels of hepatitis c virus in the blood are extremely low. about 20%-30% of people with hepatitis c have long-lasting liver scarring. if you are infected with hepatitis c and have no symptoms, there is no reason to stop taking daily doses of the prescription drug interferon.
